Fabrication of Full Dentures



- **1.** Take **preliminary alginate impressions** being sure to capture all borders and necessary landmarks. (i.e. hamular notch, retromolar pad)
- **2.** Send impression to lab for the fabrication of a **custom tray.** The tray should be made 2mm short of full extension to allow for border moulding. (4 Days)
- **3.** Border mould custom tray appropriately (i.e. compound stick, adaptal) and take **final impression.**
- **4.** Send final impression to lab for the fabrication of a **processed base with wax rim** and remount cast. (5 days)
- **5.** Seat the processed base and rim, verify fit, contour wax accordingly (i.e. horizontal plane, fox plane) and take **bite registration.**
- **6.** Send to lab to complete the trial wax set-up. (6 Days)
- **7.** Try-in the trial wax set-up, verify the bite and aesthetics.
- **8.** Return wax-set up to lab to be processed and finished. (6 Days)
- **9.** Seat finished denture and make any necessary final adjustments.
- **10.** Any resets require additional appointments.
